PASTOR'S COLUMN

Easter Sunday – 2026

As part of our preparation for the Priesthood, we spend a summer doing hospital ministry. In my group of baby chaplains I was with four others, and I was the only Christian. One day, we were discussing how we dealt with death. I prefaced my remarks by saying, “My approach to death is entirely rooted in my belief in the resurrection.” My colleagues interrupted, “By resurrection, you mean you’ll recognize those who have died through other people?” “No, I mean I will see them again!” I responded. They looked at each other and another said, “Ok, you mean you will see them in your mind when you think about them?” I responded, “**No – I will see them in their bodies and their bodies will be glorified.**” They all looked at each other in silence. Then one finally spoke out – “**You know, I guess if you really did believe that, it would change EVERYTHING!**”

He was right! What we proclaim today upends the created order! Death is destroyed! The grip of hell has no more power over us! It changes everything!

Brothers and sisters – if you haven’t been to church in awhile, welcome home! We’ve been waiting for you and praying for you!!

Not only us, but Christ Himself – He has been waiting for you – because He loves you!! He wants your love in return! He wants you to have an encounter with Him that will change EVERYTHING in your life! Continued on next page

If you enjoyed this Mass today, but you aren't regularly coming to Mass, I encourage you – pray hard! Ask the Holy Spirit to come into your heart and mind. Open up to Him who is pursuing you! He wants you to live your best life on this earth. He wants you to live a life full of joy and free from hopelessness and despair! He wants you to not stay in the shallows of spirituality, but put out into the deep and, in turn, go deep with Him!

Do this by learning to pray – not only the age-old memorized prayers, but also learn to talk to God – like one friend talking to another. It might seem a bit strange at first – but think about it. God became man. That means we can have a real relationship with Him! But even further, God got down on His knees to wash the feet of His disciples. Then He gave Himself to us as food (Communion or the Eucharist). Ultimately, He died for us, but this death smashed the gates of hell and opened heaven for us! Only because of the cross can we go to heaven – and everyone who has gone to heaven is a saint!

The resurrection indeed changes everything – it opens the path to heaven for us! Jesus wants you to follow where He has gone before! Open your heart to Him this Easter! Keep coming back to Mass! Make Christ central in your life and follow the path to heaven to become a Saint! *Siempre Adelante!*

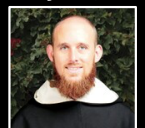
